1 Deploying Identity Management in an Enterprise

The *Oracle Fusion Middleware Enterprise Deployment Guide for Oracle Identity Management* is not available in this release.

The topologies defined in the *Oracle Fusion Middleware Enterprise Deployment Guide for Oracle Identity Management* require both Oracle Identity Management components and Oracle Identity and Access Management components to reside in the same domain.

However, only the Oracle Identity Management components have been updated for Oracle Fusion Middleware 11*g* Release 1 (11.1.1.6.0), and 11*g* Release 1 (11.1.1.6.0) components cannot be configured in the same domain with 11*g* Release 1 (11.1.1.5.0) components. This follows the general domain interoperability rule defined in the *Oracle Fusion Middleware Interoperability and Compatibility Guide*.
