## Data Conversions

The **ASR68BD.sql** file is included in this release. The installer provides all upgrades to MetaSolv Solution executable files and stored procedure files (**Procs** directory).

## Software Support

MetaSolv Solution 6.3.1 supports ASR 68 on the following software versions:

- Red Hat Enterprise Linux Server 7.1 (or later), 8 (or later), and 9 (or later)
- Oracle Solaris 11.4
- IBM AIX 7.1 Update 1
- HP-UX Itanium 11.31 Update 7
- Windows Server 2012 R2, Windows Server 2016, Windows Server 2019, and Windows Server 2022
- Oracle WebLogic Server 12.2.1.4

- Oracle Database 19c (19.3.0.0.0)

## ASR CORBA APIs Desupported

CORBA APIs are no longer supported from ASR 60. Oracle recommends that you use ASR Web Services to integrate ASR with other Oracle products or with external applications. See *ASR Web Services Developer's Guide* for more information about the ASR Web Services.

## ASOG Issues Implemented

The following table describes the Access Service Ordering Guidelines (ASOG) issues that have been implemented in this release.

Issue Number	Description
3663	The existing EVC QTY field is deleted from EVC form and is added in the Admin2 form. The validation changes are implemented in the UI and the API for the EVC QTY field in the Admin form.

Bug Number	Description
35840019	<b>Issue</b> When an order was sent from the upstream system with EVCNUM value as 1 or 2 instead of 0001 and 0002, the MSS application does not display information in <b>EVC UNI MAPPING Details</b> page. <b>Resolution</b> The user can now see the EVC UNI MAPPING Details in the ASR order when the EVCNUM value is sent with or without leading zeros in API.
34350760	<b>Issue</b> When clicking <b>Service Request Detail</b> in the <b>Connection Design</b> window, the users received an invalid service request type error for the ASR orders with the request type as <b>D- DIS</b> . <b>Resolution</b> The user can now open <b>Service Request Detail</b> from the <b>Connection Design</b> window for the ASR orders with the request type as <b>D- DIS</b> .

35823427	<p><b>Issue</b></p> <p>When previewing the ASR order, the data for some of the fields such as BDW in the <b>EVC UNI Mapping Detail</b> section are displayed incorrectly.</p> <p><b>Resolution</b></p> <p>The user can now preview ASR orders and the data in the <b>EVC UNI Mapping Detail</b> section are displayed correctly for all the fields.</p>
36007871	<p><b>Issue</b></p> <p>When installing ASR67, the logger entry <b>cmm.Integration.ASRversionAPI</b> is not added to the <b>loggingconfig.xml</b> automatically.</p> <p><b>Resolution</b></p> <p>When installing ASR version greater than 67, the logger entry <b>cmm.Integration.ASRversionAPI</b> is added to the <b>loggingconfig.xml</b> automatically.</p>

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
