#### 1.1 Clear Cache

This topic provides systematic instructions to clear the cache.

- 1. Start the Apple Safari and go to the Edit option.
- 2. Click on the Empty Cache option.

Figure 1-1 Empty the Cache Message




3. Click on the Empty button.

#### 2.1 Clearing Cache


To clear cache, follow the steps given below:


Figure 3-1 Settings pane



4. Choose **Everything** in the field of **Time range to clear** and then click on the **Clear Now** button.


# 4.2 Suppress Caching

- Click on the OK.


### 4.3 Enable Pop-ups for Oracle Banking Corporate Lending
