1.1 Release Highlights

The rationale for the release of Oracle Banking Trade Finance Process Management version 14.7.5.0.0 is to roll out additional processes and enhance existing processes in the Trade finance life cycle to support banks' Operational requirements, Customer Experience and Regulatory requirements.

1.2.1 New Processes Released

The following are the new processes released as a part of 14.7.5.0.0 Release:

- **New Processes - Conventional**
 - **Export LC Transfer Cancellation** is the new process created for Transfer LC. OBTFPM user can now initiate the Transfer LC Cancellation directly from OBTFPM system.
 - **Export LC Transfer Closure** is the new process created for Transfer LC. OBTFPM user can now initiate the Transfer LC Closure directly from OBTFPM system.
- **New Processes - Islamic**
 - **Export LC Transfer Cancellation – Islamic** is the new process created for Transfer LC. OBTFPM user can now initiate the Transfer LC Cancellation for Islamic counterpart directly from OBTFPM system.
 - **Export LC Transfer Closure – Islamic** is the new process created for Transfer LC. OBTFPM user can now initiate the Transfer LC Closure for Islamic counterpart directly from OBTFPM system.

1.2.2 Enhancements to Existing Processes

The following are the enhancement to the existing process as a part of 14.7.5.0.0 Release:

- **Export LC Amendment (Conventional and Islamic)**

- The existing screen of Export LC Amendment is enhanced to incorporate the changes because of the Transfer LC Amendment Changes.
- **Export LC Amendment Beneficiary Consent (Conventional and Islamic)**
 - The existing screen of Export LC Amendment Beneficiary Consent is enhanced to incorporate the changes because of the Transfer LC Amendment Changes
- **Export LC Transfer Amendment (Conventional and Islamic)**
 - The existing screen of Export LC Transfer Amendment is enhanced to incorporate the latest changes of Transfer LC Amendment process.

1.3 Multi entity support

The deployment model for the product now supports multiple entities of the bank. This feature will enable a single instance of the product (and the underlying Oracle Banking Microservices Architecture platform) to onboard multiple entities of the bank onto the platform. In addition, following features will be available:

- Creation of "Multi-Entity Admin" user(s)
- Entity Definition and Maintenance
- Creation of "Entity Admin" user(s) & regular users
- Mapping of users (entity admins or regular users) to one or more entities - Users of the application will be central in nature and the users can have access to one or more entities
- User Entitlement will be local to the entity
- Data segregation at entity level - at the database end, there will be segregation of data between the different entities. The different entities data will be housed in different schemas in the database. Depending on the database deployment architecture employed, these schemas for the different entities can be in the same or different PDBs of the database
- Deployment of Flyway scripts (database scripts) for an application across all entities during deployment of patches and upgrades.
- Deployments with single entity will also be deployed in the same architecture with a "default entity"
- Upgrade of existing (pre 14.5) deployments to a single entity deployment with the "default entity"
