OPERA Cloud Distribution is delivered to customers as an Oracle managed SaaS (Software as a Service) application. It is a cloud-based, mobile-enabled platform that leverages the power of Oracle Cloud Infrastructure (OCI) to deliver multi-region scalability, security, and performance. #### **Distribution Channel Management**

Bug ID	Description
36899143	In the OPERA Cloud distribution user interface, you can enter up to 631 characters in the Global Distributions Systems (GDS) long description RPD translation field for rate distribution attributes.
36697295	You can create Channel Rate Mapping and Channel Room Types Mapping for online travel agencies by navigating to Oracle Distribution > Channels > Configuration > Provisioned tab > Channel Room Type tab and Channel Rate Plan tab. Then, go to Pricing > Rate Code > View Rate Code > Channel Distribution.
36655352	You can configure the Distribution Deposit Policy with Days Before Arrival and Days After Creation set as 0 (zero).
36648312	From OPERA Cloud Distribution, you can create or modify channel room types with special character/numeric/alphabet like "-" or "*".
36610937	An issue with the online travel agency interface is resolved. In the OPERA Cloud Hotel Distribution application in Channels Configuration-> Rate Plan codes, you no longer get an error if you configure rates on the online travel agency extranet to derive from another rate on the online travel agency extranet instead of using rate updates from OPERA Cloud.
36538050	In the OPERA Cloud Distribution user interface, you can navigate to channel distribution templates at the cluster level. Selecting an existing distribution template resolves the 403 error.
36526229	With channel connectivity, you can add multiple email addresses in OPERA Cloud Distribution Property Controls.
36526220	The Channel Connectivity Distribution Channel Availability screen is enhanced.

Bug ID	Description
36563245	Channel Connectivity: Enhanced internal processing improves the performance of outbound message processing and ARI rollovers.
36430706	Channel Outbound Messages: The ARI restriction update is published only for rooms mapped for the channel rates.
36080378	The Channel Messages screen allows you to view OPERA Cloud discarded messages that were not sent to channels. This can be caused by changes affecting a room type or rate plan that not mapped for the channel.

36499921	Regarding Distribution Global Standard Codes, the Global Standard Code list for languages is revised to list only ISO Standard Language codes.

Bug ID	Description
36873037	You can create channel negotiated rates successfully if a negotiated rate linked to the profile is distributed to the target property for the first time.

#### **Distribution Reservations**

Bug ID	Description
36768152	From Channels > Channel Reservations, if reservation notifications are sent without guarantee details, the reservations are delivered to OPERA Cloud with the default guarantee code configured in Distribution.
36765312	From Channels > Channel Reservations, you can modify a reservation in OPERA Cloud without passing rate information along.
36546941	An enhancement to Distribution Channel Mapping performance prevents occasional timeouts for reservation processing coming from GDS and channels.
36543970	With channel connectivity, you can create Channel reservations in OPERA Cloud with primary and accompanying guest profiles.
