Capture client	Refer to the certification matrix for details about supported windows platforms and the compatible Capture client app version (32-bit/64-bit).

Feature	Description
CookieAllowlist MBean attribute	It's a comma-separated allowlist of cookie names in which you specify the exact cookie name for authenticating the session if the Launch Client button does not start the Capture client and no window or error is displayed. See <i>Configuring Capture MBeans</i> in <i>Administering Oracle WebCenter Enterprise Capture</i> .
WebCenter Enterprise Capture client	WebCenter Enterprise Capture now provides the Capture client via 64-bit installer, too. Both the 32-bit and the 64-bit installers are available for download on the WebCenter Enterprise Capture page. See <i>What is the Capture client?</i> and <i>Starting the Capture client</i> in <i>Using Oracle WebCenter Enterprise Capture</i> . Outside In Technology has also been upgraded to support the 64-bit version. If you install the 64-bit client, you must also install Microsoft Visual C++ 2013 redistributables (64-bit) to enable the view of PDFs, DOCX, and other non-image files on the client.

Clear metadata values in a document	You can clear all the metadata values in a document. See <i>How do I clear metadata values in a document?</i> in <i>Using Oracle WebCenter Enterprise Capture</i> .
Delete a page	In the client, you can now delete a page from a document using the Delete option from the context menu. See <i>How do I delete a page?</i> in <i>Using Oracle WebCenter Enterprise Capture</i> .
Cut/Copy pages and paste them	Cut or copy pages and paste them within the same image document or into an image document belonging to the same batch. See <i>How to cut or copy pages and paste them in image documents?</i> in <i>Using Oracle WebCenter Enterprise Capture</i> .
Replace selected page or all pages (including linked pages)	You can replace only the selected page or all the pages (including the selected page and the linked pages) in an image document. See <i>How do I replace a page?</i> in <i>Using Oracle WebCenter Enterprise Capture</i> .

deleteBatches WLST command	Use the deleteBatches WLST command to delete specific batches. See deleteBatches in <i>WebCenter WLST Command Reference</i> .
exportIMAPEmailMessage WLST command	Use the exportIMAPEmailMessage WLST command to export an IMAP email message with specified messageId to the specified file. See exportIMAPEmailMessage in <i>WebCenter WLST Command Reference</i> .
exportEWSEmailMessage WLST command	Use the exportEWSEmailMessage WLST command to export an EWS email message with specified messageId to the specified file. See exportEWSEmailMessage in <i>WebCenter WLST Command Reference</i> .

Capturing and use of TWAIN related metadata	Ability to control and receive the scanner's imprinter/endorser string and the ability to retrieve bar codes, patch codes, and MICR values recognized by the scanner. See ImageCaptureEngine.
Updates to File Information window in the Capture client	Addition of Endorsement and MICR properties to the File Information window in the Capture client. See How do I view file information?
