WebCenter Forms Recognition RESTful API provides methods to upload and manage external documents. The uploaded documents are further processed by Runtime Server (RTS).

## 3 Upload External Documents

To upload external documents complete the following steps:

1. Authenticate with a valid user that has **AEB** or **ADM** role.
2. Create an import group.
3. Create an external batch within the import group.
4. Add one or more documents to the external batch.
5. Set the external batch to **Ready** for the Import status.

### 3.1 Authenticate Credentials and Grant Access Token

#### 3.1.1 POST /api/v1/Authentication

#### 3.1.2 Implementation Notes

To gain access to WFR API, the user must be authenticated. The user must be a valid user that has AEB or ADM role.

Upon successful validation of credentials, a bearer token is returned which can then be used to authenticate subsequent calls to WFR API.

By default, a bearer token is valid for 60 minutes.

### 4.4 Create an External Batch Within an Import Group

This request creates an external batch within an import group.

---

**Notes:** External batches are sets of one or more documents to be imported. The external batch is created inside an import group. If the indicated import group does not yet exist, it will be created. Optionally, names can be assigned to each batch. When an external batch is created, it is empty and has a status value of 10 indicating that documents can be added.

### 4.5 Set the Status of an External Batch

Provided that the external batch has not been locked for processing, the status can be set to any value between 10 and 999.

---

**Note:** Only a batch at status less than 20 can be set to Ready for Import (status 20).
