Graph API	The Microsoft Graph API connection protocol for email import allows you to enable multi-factor authentication for your primary email access through standard clients. Functionality to release failed batches	You can select failed batches in the Capture client and release them to the same process. For details, see <i>How do I complete processing batches and release them?</i> in <i>Using Oracle WebCenter Enterprise Capture</i> .
Abandon Batch Lock	This feature allows you to unlock other users' batches if you have the Capture workspace manager role. See <i>How do I abandon batch lock?</i> in <i>Using Oracle WebCenter Enterprise Capture</i> .
